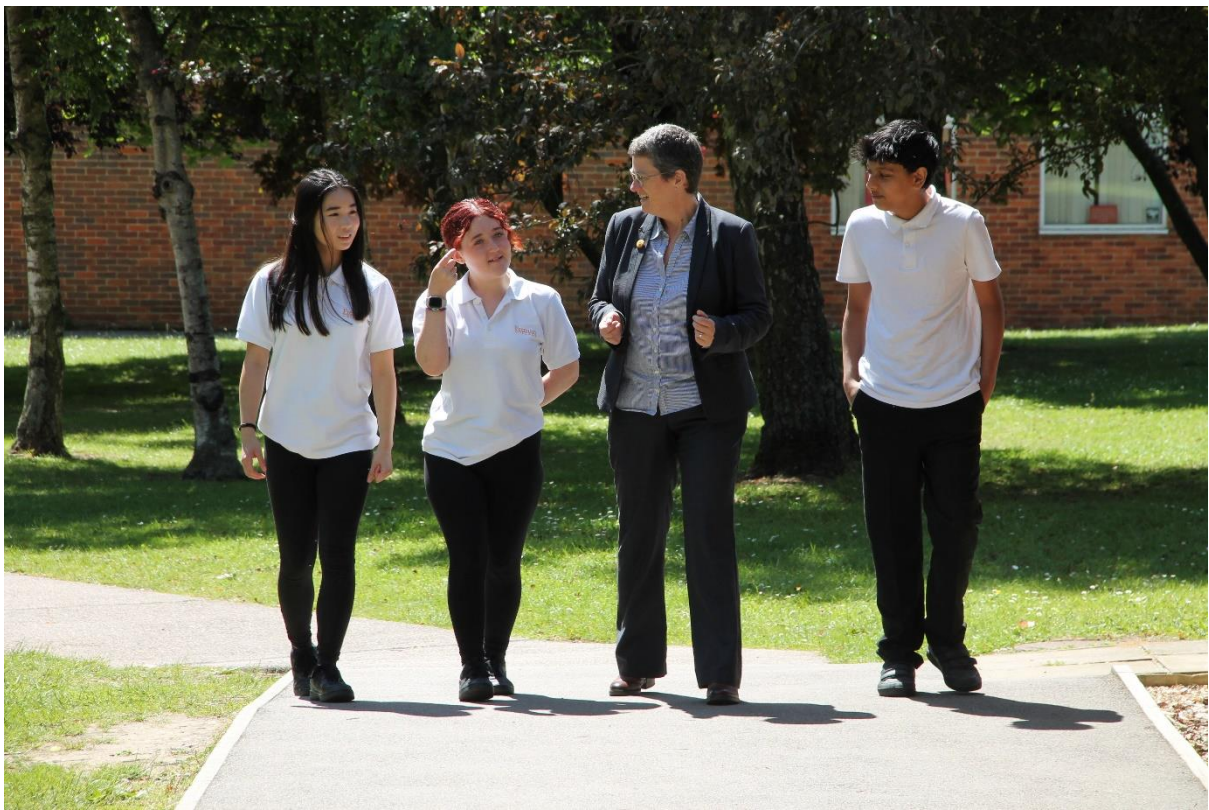

FAMILY

Freman College boasts a friendly and supportive staff and we aim to support staff to maintain a work / life balance.

We have adopted the Hertfordshire County Council Family and Carer's Guide, which includes Maternity, Paternity, Adoption and Carer's leave.

Since 2018 the Childcare Voucher Scheme is not eligible for new joiners; you now apply for tax-free childcare (TFC) directly from the Government. However, if you are currently in a scheme you may be able to transfer to our scheme via Computershare.

EXCELLENT LOCATION

Buntingford is a hidden gem in the Hertfordshire countryside lying alongside the River Rib. This market town is a short drive from Stevenage, Baldock, Royston, Cambridge, Bishop's Stortford, Hertford and Ware; and sits midway between London and Cambridge. There is an active community with a popular U3A, thriving Scouting community and good facilities for adults and children. There are a variety of shops, pubs and restaurants and a market every Monday.

HEALTH and WELL BEING

The Fitness Suite located in our Sports Hall is available for use by staff. The suite has a range of cardio machines such as treadmills, elliptical trainers, spin bikes, rowing machines as well as a variety of weight and strength training machines. Staff are inducted in its use by our PE staff.
