

Description of Duties

Job title: Play work Leader/Supervisor & Play work Assistant Requirement (Play work Leader/Supervisor): Minimum Level 3 qualification in Childcare or equivalent.

Requirement (Play work Assistant): No qualification, but Level 2 or equivalent is desirable.

Responsible to (Play work Leader/Supervisor): To the Business director/owner

Responsible to (Play work Assistant): To the Play work Leader/Supervisor

General/daily Duties:

- 1. To ensure the club runs smoothly and in line with Ofsted's regulations.
- 2. To ensure the safe arrival and departure of children and accurately populate the relevant registers daily.
- 3. Play work Leader is responsible for overall daily management of the setting.
- 4. To assist in ensuring the children have planned play activities weekly.
- 5. To ensure Safeguarding of the children is always everyone's responsibility.
- 6. To engage with the children during their play sessions, indoors and outdoors.
- 7. To encourage positive behaviour by presenting yourself as a good role model and to always act in a responsible manner towards children and staff.
- 8. To assist in ensuring the safety of all children at the setting in the event of a fire/drill or any other emergency.
- 9. To be responsible, with other team members to ensure all setting's belongings and equipment are properly used, maintained and stored away appropriately.
- 10. To report any damaged furniture, games/toys or setting's items to the director/owner.
- 11. To help to ensure that the areas used by the club are left tidy and clean as met.
- 12. To keep confidential any information regarding children, families or staff that has been gained during work duties.
- 13. Play work Leaders would undergo Paediatric First Aid training every three years and administer first aid as and when required.
- 14. To liaise with parents and carers only on matters of their child's day to day welfare.
- 15. To attend meetings as and when required.
- 16. To undertake any training relevant to the effectiveness of the post.
- 17. To prepare or supervise the preparation of a substantial snack for the children.
- 18. To undertake any other reasonable duties as directed by the director/owner for the benefit of the setting.
