MAIN PURPOSE

The cleaning operative is responsible for maintaining a clean and hygienic environment throughout the primary school, ensuring a safe and healthy environment for pupils and staff.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Undertake cleaning of allocated areas in line with specified standards and as directed.
- Operate / use domestic and industrial cleaning equipment and materials, following appropriate training.
- Store allocated equipment and materials safely and securely.
- Perform duties in line with health and safety regulations (COSHH) and act where hazards are identified, report serious hazards to line manager immediately.
- Collect and dispose of waste.
- Refill and replace soap, towels, and other materials.
- Undertake additional cleaning schedules during school closures or other designated periods.
- Responsible for the safe use, care and storage of equipment and materials.
- Demonstrate cleaning duties to new or less experienced staff

The duties and responsibilities listed above describe the post as it is at present. The post holder is expected to accept any reasonable alterations that may from time to time be necessary.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITES

- Promote, act as a role model, and implement Fairlands Primary School's policies, practices and procedures
 including those relating to equality and diversity.
- Demonstrate day to day commitment to the school's core values: Fairlands Achieves, Includes, Respects
- Read and follow the relevant school policies.
- Undertake training required to develop in the role.

JOB CONTEXT

The team of cleaning staff are primarily tasked with ensuring the site is clean, presentable, safe, and secure for all those that use it in any capacity.
