Learning Support Assistant H2

Date: September 2022

Pay Scale: H2

Hours: Mon-Fri 8.20am – 3.20pm. Term-time only (38 weeks) plus two training days

Reporting to: Head/Deputy Head of Inclusion

Purpose of the role: To work with teachers to support teaching and learning, providing general and specific assistance to students and staff under the direction, guidance and direct supervision of the classroom teacher.

Responsibilities:

- Work with individuals or small groups of students in the classroom under the direct supervision of teaching staff and provide feedback to the teacher
- Support students to understand instructions support independent learning and inclusion of all students
- Support the teacher in behaviour management and keeping students on task
- Support students in social and emotional well-being, reporting problems to the teacher as appropriate
- Prepare and clear up learning environment and resources, including photocopying, filing and the display and presentation of students work and contribute to maintaining a safe environment
- Supporting the SEMH of students and reporting concerns following RPS Safeguarding procedures.

Learning Support Assistants in this role may also undertake some or all of the following:

- Record basic student data
- Attend progress meetings/parent meetings with the SENDCo and parent/carers
- Mentoring/being a key worker for students and keeping accurate records of meetings
- Support children's learning- adapting resources/scaffolding learning/chunking activities
- Assist with break-time supervision including facilitating games and activities
- Assist with escorting students on educational visits
- Support students in using basic ICT
- Invigilate exams and tests
- Assist students with eating, dressing and hygiene, as required, whilst encouraging independence.
