Class Teachers have a vital role to play in the planning and delivery of the curriculum, the formation of and reporting on Individual Education Plan targets and the pastoral welfare of pupils.

The Management of Teaching and Learning

- Responsible for a group of pupils in Amwell View School, and to carry out the professional duties of a teacher as circumstances may require
- Responsible for the long, medium and short term planning of the curriculum and the day to day delivery of lessons, in accordance with the schemes of work
- Responsible for the management of pupil behaviour in accordance with school policy and practice

Monitoring and Evaluation
